Attendance: Roll will be taken daily and all absences and tardiness recorded.

Course Content: Math will be a 2-hour block using the Agile Minds Curriculum. The modules under this curriculum are built around the Louisiana Math Standards. Students will receive a personal workbook and log in credentials to the digitized platform.

Grades: Grades will be determined based on a point system. Students will be given several opportunities to earn points based on the broad topics below:

- **Tests (Topic/Module/Skills tests)** - Tests will be cumulative and will be administered when a set of skills have been completed and need to be mastered before advancing to the next concept. Tests will consist of a variety of question formats and can be either paper or computer based. I will announce tests in advance.
- **Quizzes** - These will most times be announced in advance but occasionally a pop-up quiz will occur during class with an announcement at the beginning of class.
- **Homework** - Daily homework will be given and checked. See Middle School Homework and Testing Policy
