All assessments will be cumulative and contain a variety of question formats. I will announce all assessments in advance.

All courses are completely aligned with the Louisiana Math Standards. I will not be teaching the Eureka Modules in numerical order. I will be utilizing the alternative sequence for implementing Eureka math. Late Assignment Policy
