Attendance

Course Content

- Each student will receive login information for Agile Mind, as well as a physical workbook.
- Each student will also receive login information for the Google Classroom created for each course.
- Chromebooks are available for student use during class time, and a laptop or other device is recommended for course work completed at home.
- Off-campus students must refer to Google Classroom daily for uploads and assessments, paying particular attention to due dates.

Grades

- A numerical grade will be computed for each student based on unit tests, quizzes, bell-ringers, exit tickets, and other assessments. A variety of assessments are utilized, and students should expect several “small” assessments each week as well as the “big” tests that are administered as content is mastered.
- Any assessment completed on paper at home must be turned in at the beginning of the class period on the due date to receive full credit.
- Any online assessment must be completed before the posted deadline.
